
Articulate Studio '09 Quizmaker Settings for TrainTraq

There are two ways completions can be recorded in TrainTraq:

- Number of slides viewed
- Quiz results (only one quiz can be used to in which to base a completion)

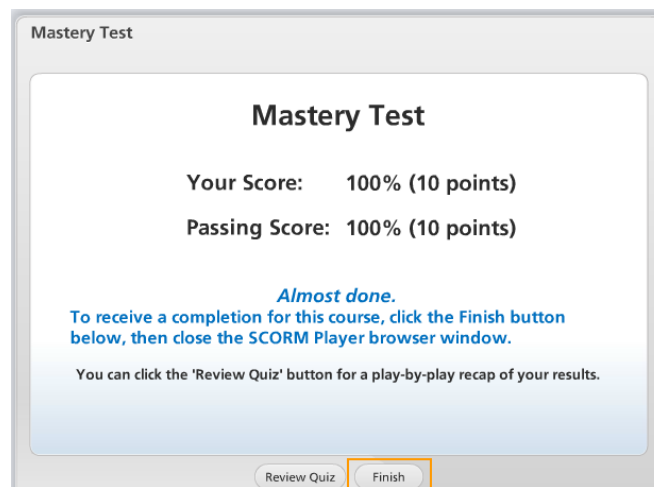


Figure 1. The quiz should have a **Finish** button that will close the browser window when complete.

It is recommended to have completions based on a quiz. For the completion to record properly in TrainTraq, the quiz must have the **Finish** button enabled. The user should be instructed to click the **Finish** button and then close the course browser window as shown in Figure 1. The following instructions detail how to implement these settings before you publish your course for TrainTraq.

Change the properties of your quiz

1. Open your **PowerPoint** file and locate the quiz slide you will use in which to base your completion.
2. Click **Properties** and for the field **On passing, 'Finish' button:**, select the option that says **Closes Window**. It will be the very first option in the menu.
3. Click **Close**.

Edit the Pass Results slide in your quiz.

1. Remain on your quiz slide and click **Edit in Quizmaker**.
2. Click **Pass Result** at the top.
3. You can add the following instructions to the text, "In order to receive a completion, click the Finish button below, then close the SCORM Player browser window."
4. Click **Save and Close**.
5. Click **Save and Return to Presenter**. You will be taken back to PowerPoint. Save your file.
